Federal and State Aid

To determine what additional aid you may be eligible for, file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov. Federal and state aid include Pell Grants, Iowa Tuition Grants, work study and student loans.

Scholarships are determined by a combination of **unweighted** GPA and ACT/SAT score (optional). Scholarships and grants are renewable for four years of undergraduate study. Increases in scholarship awards due to change in GPA or test scores will be reviewed until **March 1**.
